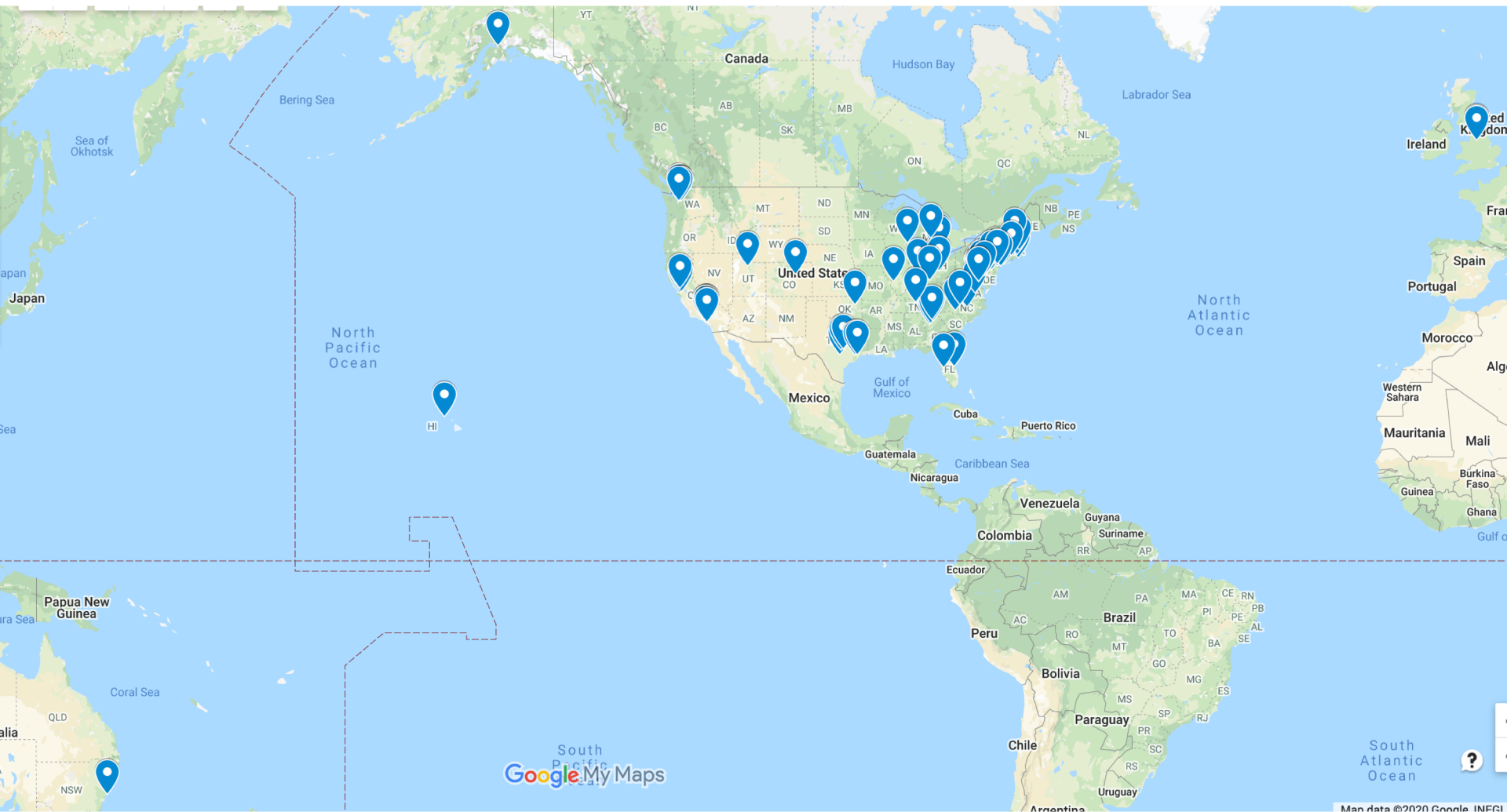

Episode 28: State Quiz Game



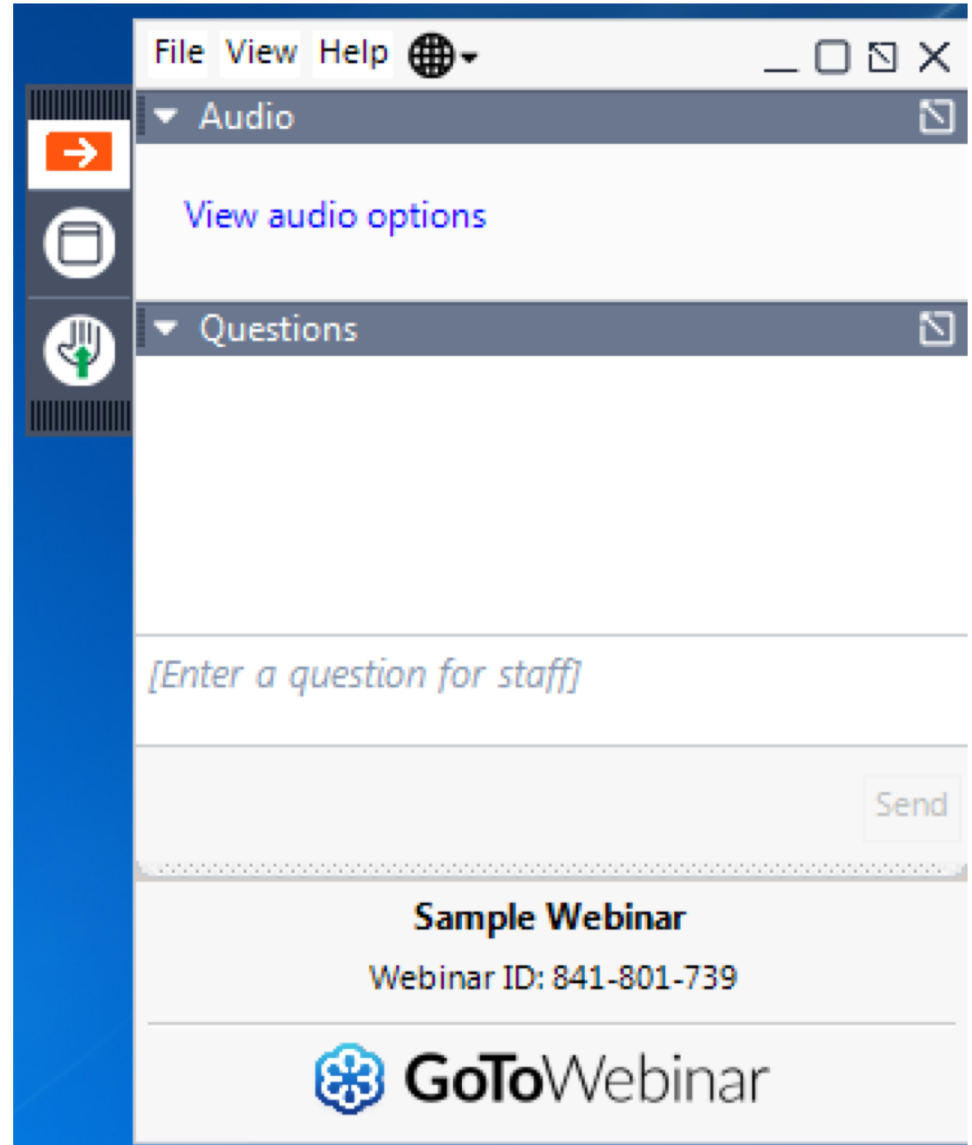

Raise Hand



Ask Question



You need two variables

correct = 0

questions = 3

#Main Loop – has an intro, then a series of questions

print("Welcome to the state capital quiz game!")

---- question 1 ----

print("1) What is the Capitol of Alabama?")

print("""a. Little Rock

b. Mobile

c. Montgomery

d. Burmingham""")

answer = input(">")

if answer == "c":

correct += 1

print("Correct! Good Job.\n")

else:

print("Sorry, that is not correct.")

print("The correct answer was c.\n")

---- end ----

"""

After the last question, calculate the score and print the results

"""

score = correct/total_questions*100

#score = round(correct/questions*100)

print("Quiz complete")

print("You scored a ", score, "%")

#print("You scored a ", str(score) + "%")

Notes:

- 1) In the print use """ (triple quotes) to display the text with the line breaks
- 2) Think about \n in the print to force line breaks
- 3) Add the correct answer when they get it wrong
- 4) Use the round() function in the end to make the score more friendly
